“Support for Delivering the Basic Package of Health Services in Liberia”

The mission of the Ministry of Health and Social Welfare is to reform the health sector to effectively deliver quality health and social welfare services to the people of Liberia.

Non-governmental, faith-based and other civil society partners will be involved in the reform through conventions or contracts to ensure that their actions are coherent with the National Health Plan as well as to increase transparency, efficiency and effectiveness.

The MOHSW now Requests for Proposals (RFP) from interested non-governmental, faith-based and other civil society organizations with a proven record of providing healthcare in Liberia for a performance-based contract to support delivering the Basic Package of Health Services.

With funds from the Health Sector Pool Fund, this RFP will ensure provision of the full Basic Package of Health Services in six clusters, comprised of 54 health facilities in total. The MOHSW expects to award six contracts under this RFP, one per cluster. The complete list of facilities to be supported can be found in the RFP document.

Other health facilities across the country will continue to be supported during this period with funds from other sources including USAID, the European Commission, as well as the Government of Liberia.

Proposals must be in the prescribed format, fulfill the criteria described in the full RFP document, and be received no later than February 5, 2010. All proposals must be submitted according to the submission instructions in the RFP.

The services are expected to commence on April 1, 2010 for an initial period of 15 months, until June 30, 2011 with the possibility of an annual extension thereafter, subject to performance, for a total of 27 months.
